

Member Alert-Bleeding Control Kits

The Stop the Bleed Initiative has brought together a number of federal agencies, non-profit organizations and corporations to develop and disseminate resources to train the public in bleeding control. Bleeding Control Kits are intended to provide the essential life-saving equipment necessary in the event of a major trauma crisis for example a school shooting, as well as to address more common everyday emergencies on campus; vehicle accidents, sports related injuries, classroom mishaps until emergency personnel has arrived.

An acronym to summarize the necessary response is THREAT:

- T**hreat suppression
- H**emorrhage control **R**apid
- E**xtrication to safety
- A**ssessment by medical providers
- T**ransport to definitive care

Training is required for Bleeding Control Kits - Tactical Response to Traumatic Injuries Act **AB-1708 Emergency Response: Trauma Kits.**

The entity with onsite Trauma Kits/Bleed Kits must:

- Periodically inspect and replace the contents of the kit
- Restock the kit after each use
- Notify tenants of the building or structure of the location of the trauma kit
- Update the districts Emergency Response Plan to reflect the kits.
